## UPDATE Covid-19 precautions

November is here and we are ready for it!

ACC Adult Home Care continues to work extremely hard in keeping our Covid-19 protocols and precautions as up to date as possible. We can proudly say that, thankfully, we haven't had any positive cases within our clients and staff members. Here's an update on what we've added and continue to do.

What we've recently added:

1. During the cold and flu season, extra covid-19 precautions are now mandatory while caring for clients in facilities. Face shields are to be worn along with the standard face masks while in close contact care with the client. Face shields were provided to all caregivers.

What we continue to do:

2. We are still requiring all our field staff to take their temperature before each shift and must report if temperature is over 100.4 for quick management.
3. They must wash their hands prior to arrival to shift, before leaving the shift, before food prep or serving and after close contact with client.
4. Appropriate and safe distance from visitors, other staff members and/or family members. And wear mask when in close distance.
5. Gloves need to be worn when entering client's home, when providing hands-on care and when documenting in clients chart.
6. Maintaining clean and disinfected surfaces in the home before and after every shift.
7. Change into clean uniforms between clients' homes.
